Australian High Commissioner to India Inaugurates 'Greenhouse Center of Learning' at VidyaGyan Sitapur

Lucknow, April 20, 2017: VidyaGyan, a leadership academy for meritorious and economically underprivileged students from rural Uttar Pradesh, today announced the inauguration of a Greenhouse Center of Learning at its Sitapur campus by Her Excellency Ms Harinder Sidhu, the Australian High Commissioner to India. The center was inaugurated in the presence of Ms Roshni Nadar Malhotra, CEO, HCL Corporation and Chairperson, VidyaGyan.

The newly established "Greenhouse Center of Learning" is located in the seven-acre Mango Orchard at the Sitapur Campus and offers a physical learning space that seamlessly integrates the formal set-up of classroom training with the openness of nature. The center is aimed at facilitating an inspiring, innovative and creative learning environment for the students of VidyaGyan and comprises three open and glass topped class-rooms, named Chintan, Chetan and Srijan. Expanding on VidyaGyan's pedagogical approach, the Greenhouse Center of Learning will help students adopt a more collaborative learning methodology instead of the traditional instructional method encouraging students to learn by doing or creating.

Inaugurating the Greenhouse Centre of Learning, H.E. Ms. Harinder Sidhu, Australian High Commissioner to India said, "VidyaGyan is a great model as it addresses the basic problem of every developing nation regarding, unequal access to learning and growth opportunities. I am delighted to be at VidyaGyan and to launch the Greenhouse Centre for Learning. The Australian High Commission and VidyaGyan have been partnering for a couple of years now where we have been supporting the VidyaGyan students towards enhancing their communication skills through our Direct Aid Program. I happy to see the progress made by these gifted students through our support."

Speaking on the occasion, **Roshni Nadar Malhotra, Chairperson, VidyaGyan** said, "We are delighted to have H.E.
